




TexTailor Expo 2023 took place from **October 5 to 7, 2023** in Pavilion 2 of **International Fair Plovdiv.** The fourth edition of the forum presented the current trends and technologies in the production and design of clothing.

The teams of **International Fair Plovdiv and Spex Ltd.** joined forces again to organize it.

They worked in **partnership with the Bulgarian Association of Textile Apparel and Leather.**



The fourth edition of the exhibition attracted more than 62 companies from **Bulgaria, Germany, Greece, India, Spain, Italy, China, Poland, and Turkey.**

We've marked an increase in exhibitors focused on ecology, economy and business models in the fashion industry.

For the first time, the exhibition was enhanced with another thematic focus: interior design. Italian upholstered furniture impressed with stylish furnishing proposals.

Another novelty was the presentation of **a men's fashion line of a leading** brand from Poland and children's clothing.

Chinese and Indian manufacturers exhibited a variety of textiles for evening, sports and casual fashion, all types of yarns and threads and their latest models of spinning looms and related equipment.

A finishing machinery factory successfully participated with advanced ironing presses and equipment for cotton printing, Liene printing, silk printing and mixed fabrics.

"TexTailor Expo 2023 provided exhibitors and visitors with a rich and useful supporting program. The events on the schedule took place in creatively organized dedicated spaces in Pavilion No. 2.

The three-day exhibition was saturated with fashion shows, workshops and trainings, presentations of innovations and visions in the fashion industry. All segments were covered: haute couture, boutique lines and prêt-à-porter, knitwear and leatherwear, footwear and industry-related accessories. A special highlight of the three-day exhibition was the design workshop CreativeLab of the famous designer with Prof. Ivan Donev, winner of 20 awards from world forums.

TAILOR YOUR MIND

The exhibition reinforced its mission to support start-up brands by providing an opportunity to exhibit alongside established companies and fashion brands.

For the first time, the start-up zone was that large and included 12 companies. In addition to their own stands, they had the opportunity to show their collections of clothes, shoes and accessories with a fashion show.

Online store: building and development

Special guest speaker of the fourth edition was **Kiril Velkov**, **UX expert in building successful online stores.** He gave valuable guidance and advice on winning practices and trends in the online fashion industry.

TexTailor Fashon Show

The final glamorous event gathered hundreds of visitors in Pavilion 2. It opened up with a fashion show of Bulgarian universities and schools of textile and fashion and ended with a show of **the KOEFIA Academy of Rome**.





The audience was fascinated by models and designers whose creativity conquers the world's catwalks and stages: **ELLEN MORE**, **Wolf Walley**, **REFLET**, **AZARIA**.

For the first time, a unique garment that took 600 hours to embroider was shown on a Bulgarian catwalk.

An official award ceremony for the finalists in the Tailor Your Mind competition took place with a lot of emotion. Discovering and promoting new talent in fashion is one of the main goals, challenges and visions of TexTailor Expo.





The Tailor Your Mind competition is an initiative of the fashion designer Ivan Donev himself. He established it in the fashion industry as a platform for the most promising national and international young fashion designers and emerging auteur brands. The finalists were announced by Prof. Ivan Donev, and the grand prize of the competition was a one-year scholarship to study at the KOEFIA Academy of Rome.
